YOUTH JOB CONNECTION

Youth Job Connection is a new program for unemployed youth aged **15-29** who experience multiple and/or complex barriers to employment.

Objective: The program offers a range of services and opportunities for young people to learn about jobs and gain experience working so that they may eventually secure long-term employment and meaningful careers.

Participants will receive:

- Paid pre-employment training to promote job readiness
- Job matching and placement supports
- Mentorship services
- Education and work transition assistance which will include: ongoing one-on-one career coaching, leadership and networking opportunities

Outcome:

- Employment and improved long-term employability
- Short-term training
- Education: returning to school and/or other academic upgrading

To be eligible, you must:

- Be between 15 to 29 years old at time of registration
- Be legally excused from attending high school if you are 15 to 18 years old
- Be eligible to work in Canada
- Be a resident of Ontario
- Not be currently in full time training or education
- Be unemployed
